### **New Activities for Canal Days**



To add interest to our expanded and renovated canal museum, we had demonstrations, "hands-on" activities, and a special display for Canal Days.

The demonstrations included quilting, crocheting, caning, and making homemade ice cream.

In addition, various "hands-on" activities were available throughout the museum . These included grinding your own coffee, using a

treadle sewing machine, doing laundry the old-fashioned way, making music with a player piano,

typing with an old manual typewriter, cranking an apple peeler, and using a corn sheller.







A special display was located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor featured Grandma's Homemaking Memories with "The Flour Sack," "Mama's Mixing Bowl"," Making Kraut", and "Making Candles."

### **Iron Lift Bridge**

The museum recently received a working model of the Second Street bridge, complete with counterbalance weights and a chain pulley to lift the bridge and allow canal boats to pass. This model was made and donated by Bill Hemker who worked from several pictures of the structure. It makes a nice addition, allowing visitors, especially children, to see how lift bridges actually worked.



### **Marguerite Home at Last**







It doesn't look like much yet, but the remains of the Marguerite, Delphos' last canal boat, are finally home in the Delphos Canal Commission Museum. She spent the past 25 years stored in a barn and then in a semi trailer, but Wednesday night, 12 volunteers carried her to her final resting place. Helping with the move were Kevin Wieging and Kevin Kohorst, two of the former Squires who dug her out of the canal in 1987, as well as Canal Commission Trustee Lou Hohman, who was the advisor of the Squires at the time. Wieging's son, Justin, a present-day Squire, was also on hand as were Bob Ebbeskotte, Arnie and Curtis Hoersten, Chuck Wannemacher, who supplied the semi, and trustees Ed Ulrich, Dave Burnett, Tom Miller and Steve Dorsten. Reconstruction work will begin soon.

A follow-up visit to the museum by the St. Johns's 4<sup>th</sup> graders has already been done and Franklin 4<sup>th</sup> graders will be visiting in the spring.

## **Maintenance**

Last fall we learned we would have to replace our 36 year old furnace and air conditioning unit which had been installed by Bill Hemker and Reliable Heating and Plumbing in 1976. The furnace was a hazard and needed to be replaced immediately and parts were no longer available to repair the A/C. We were able to cut the cost by doing some of the work ourselves. Volunteers have cut holes and installed several registers to allow heat to get to the second floor, but duct work will be run as well.

A new water heater and plumbing have been installed in the basement and the area is being revamped for more display area.
